Hill to Richard B. Angus

Re a bank defalcation of \$35,000 by head book-keeper. Manvel works too hard: "I fear that his health will be seriously impaired unless he spends more time out of his office. Re land troubles incurred in building stone arch bridge over Hennepin Island (Farnham & Lovejoy property) & eventual purchase of their entire property for \$112,500. Re case of Chute & Eastman now pending in Supreme Court. Minneapolis Union Ry will have to pay the Water-power Company. When I see you I want to arrange that "I will not be always compelled to

give my entire time to the Ry. I am ready to
confess that I am sometimes tired."
